This book is number 30 in the Law in Africa Series and is intended primarily for non-law students. It will be of special use to students in commercial colleges. It draws exclusively

from local case material, statutes and from articles written on East African law. It includes several unreported decisions of the High Courts of the three countries. The largest section covers cases on the law of contract; an outline of the court system is included; also an explanation of the importance of East African and English cases.
