This collection of readings is designed for teachers and students interested in the principles and problems of public revenue systems in Africa, - particularly in Anglophonic Africa since selections are confined to those written in the English language. It does not purport to have the unity and cohesiveness of a text but rather presents varying theories and points of view. Principal stress is placed on the economic aspects of raising revenues rather than administrative, legal or political issues. The twenty-one readings are divided into five categories: fiscal policy and economic development; tax policy and economic development; direct taxes; indirect taxes; and other ancillary issues.
